OBJECTIVE & CHALLENGE

When it all started 3 years ago, it was just one clinic in Secunderabad. The

primary objective was to get more patients to the clinic, followed by;

- Building a strong brand name.
- Improve overall patient/user experience by anchoring its web presence locally (later, for all of their branches)
- ▶ Improve search engine visibility and conversions (for all the branches)

The clinic is specialised in treating diseases which people found very **embarrassing** even to talk to a doctor about it. From a **marketing perspective**, promoting treatment for this was the most challenging aspect of this project.

SOLUTION

After understanding the target market, the first thing we did was to convert the **embarrassment** factor into our advantage by making it the '**attention grabber**' towards the clinic.


